

# Goal of the meeting - Organising the large community support

## How the goal will be achieved

- Getting everyone's contact details so we can continue to be an organised group after the meeting
- Establishing strategies to fight the proposed changes
- Putting a group/s together to give people a point of contact and implement the strategies i.e. the formation of a general working committee

Areas where a specific strategy is required:

1. Community support strategy
2. Council communication strategy
3. Media strategy

Discuss the establishment of small working groups to develop plans and execute plans around the three areas listed above.

## Community support strategy

- Discuss timetables for events, public awareness events.
- Discuss how we can ensure the public submissions are as effective as possible
- Discuss how to get the word out: Flyers, T-shirts, Posters, leaflet drop etc.
- Petitions
- Delegate someone to head up the community support strategies and/or a working group

## Council communication strategy

- Two sections - how can we influence Council's report and how can we influence the Councillors vote
- Discuss the councillors reasons for proposing the changes, and how we can rebut each reason – this could be done by a working group
- Discuss how we can put a well-reasoned evidence based response to council and the councillors
  - a. Should we make a group submission with all members of the group as signatories?
  - b. Provide the community with the arguments and let everyone respond separately?
- Discuss if/how we should lobby or put pressure on the Councillors directly
- Discuss verbal submissions to council. Who, when what the message is.
- Set up a group to implement these responses and strategies
- Should there be a longer term political strategy?

## Media strategy

- Anyone work in the media or knows anyone who does?
- Discuss how we can ensure the media present our evidence based arguments
- Delegate someone to be the media contact for the group as a whole
